SENIOR MEAL DELIVERY PROGRAM

600 SENIORS served

United Way of Lewis County, in partnership with Lewis County Seniors and Twin Transit, created the Senior Meal Program to keep those 60 and over in their homes and receiving meals through a weekly meal delivery service.



RENT/UTILITY/CHILDCARE ASSISTANCE DUE TO JOB LOSS

46 HOUSEHOLDS

In partnership with the Community Action Council of Lewis, Mason, and Thurston County, provided 46 local households (144 individuals) with critical housing services for those experiencing job loss.
