Emergency Management Preliminary Damage Assessment

Initial reporting to the State for a request to the President for a Declaration of Disaster. **Without this process, no FEMA money can be made available.** If sufficient damage is documented, citizens then need to make a formal claim with FEMA. The FEMA phone number (for reporting) is released only **after** a Presidential Declaration is made.



Team Rubicon is a volunteer organization working with DEM, who will be going house-to-house to assist with site assessments and cleanup efforts.

Inspection teams may be in the area after the Preliminary Damage Assessment is completed to verify damages for the Presidential Declaration process. Only when enough damage is documented do funds become available to citizens
