## **46 HOUSEHOLDS**

In partnership with the Community Action Council of Lewis, Mason, and **Thurston County, provided 46 local** households (144 individuals) with critical housing services for those experiencing job loss.

Through the Boys & Girls Club of Chehalis, provided a week of free, full day child support services to 35 families in Lewis County, and 10 families financially impacted by COVID-19 summer camp scholarships.
